## CS 321 HCI Observation/Note Taking Assignment

## Purpose:

To observe and describe a work setting, an individual working within that setting, and the actions of the individual. To practice developing field notes and interpreting observation data

## Activity:

- Select a person performing an activity in a public space such as a restaurant, health club, the student union, or a shopping center and observe them for a minimum of 10 minutes.
- 2. The person you observe must be a stranger to you. If you feel it is appropriate, you may want to introduce yourself and ask if you can observe them, explaining that it is part of a class assignment and assure them of confidentiality.
- 3. Make detailed notes while you observe. You must include descriptions of the physical setting (make a sketch of the layout), the person, the actions of the person, and any thoughts that occur to you about the work the individual is doing while you are observing.
- 4. Create field notes from the data you collected.
- 5. Use either the two-column format or the wide left margin format.
- 6. Must be word processed (all work in this class should be word processed and printed).
- 7. Field notes will be graded on detail, clarity, and implications/conclusions drawn.

NOTE: You must choose someone <u>active</u> who is doing something interesting.
